

Week for Action on NCDs GPS Drawing Challenge

Inspired by the new visual and graphic identity of the Week for Action on NCDs (W4A) that invokes movement and momentum, NCDA has launched a challenge encouraging physical activity during the W4A!

The **GPS Drawing Challenge** encourages NCD community members to use the GPS function of their mobile phone to write a message they want to communicate for the W4A on a map.

GPS drawing is a technique of using a GPS device (usually a mobile phone) to follow a pre-planned route and create a large-scale picture or text on a map.

You're the pencil and the world is your canvas!

App downloaded, what about now?

It's time to find your message!

- A few examples: ACT, ACT on NCDs, W4A on NCDs, Action on NCDs;
- Let your imagination run wild and let us know why it's time to act on NCDs.
- Coordinate and unite with friends and colleagues, e.g. from different countries and regions! Each teammate could be in charge of "drawing" one letter of your message.
- Put your organisation's name in a message e.g. NCD Alliance Acts On NCDs.
- Address your government, e.g. *Minister be accountable for NCD action*
- Write in your language e.g. Actuar contra las ENT

Message found? Let's plan!

Study the streets around your area or find a wide empty space (football pitch, field, etc) where you will 'draw' your message.






Ready, set, go!

It's time to go out and draw! Before you start two important things to keep in mind:

- 1. Safety first! Remember to stay compliant with the COVID19 social distancing rules that may in place in your country.
- 2. Have fun! There are no requirements regarding the sport, pace and distance to cover.

1- Take a screenshot of your drawing

Click on the Android or Apple logo for a tutorial for your device

2- Part of a team?

Put someone in charge of collecting the different letters of your message using his/her favourite messaging app (iMessages, WhatsApp, Telegram, Signal, etc). They can then 'paste' them all together int one picture.

3- Launch your favourite social media platform

Post on social media - like Twitter, LinkedIn, Instagram, & Facebook. Remember to tag with #ActOnNCDs
